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OVERVIEW

Artemis Virtual Academy is Huntsville City Schools' hybrid virtual school. Any student who lives in Huntsville City school district can apply.

Artemis allows families the flexibility of homeschool but with access to a guaranteed and viable curriculum that aligns with Alabama Course of Study Standards while also getting individualized academic support from qualified teachers.

OPPORTUNITIES

- Artemis students may still participate in extracurricular activities at the zoned schools, including sports, band and JROTC.
- When space is available, students can take special courses at their zoned school that are offered at Artemis.
- Artemis offers optional activities and events throughout the year to give students the opportunity to collaborate and interact with their peers.



HOW TO APPLY

- Applications for fall semester open in March. Applications for spring semester open in November.
- Criteria for applying: Students should be in good standing with their zoned schools in regards to grades and attendance, as well as be able to self-regulate their learning.
- Applications will be posted on the HCS website and the Artemis website.

ATTENDANCE

Artemis students must login to the online curriculum each school day to complete their daily assignments to be marked present for the day.



COMMUNICATION

Each student must have a designated learning coach committed to supporting the student at home. This coach is responsible for ensuring the student logs in daily to complete assignments.
